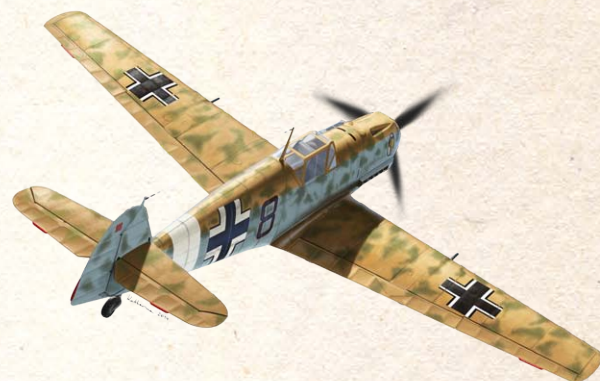
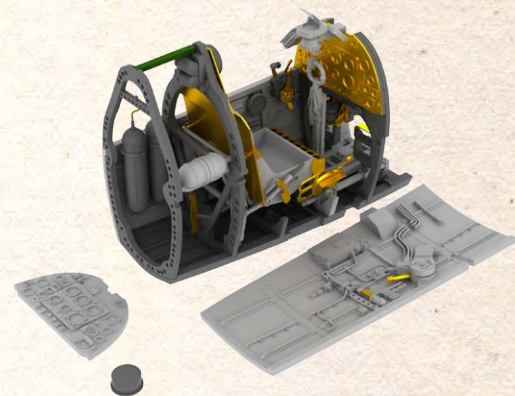

EDITORIAL

Dear Friends,

Here we are in the New Year and at a new beginning. The last year was an eventful one, many things worked out well, others did not, and what did not will be made right this year. The main topic of discussion that falls into the latter category was the Bf 109G project, which we temporarily suspended after a wave of criticism and our decision to rework the model. The rework is nearing completion. Aside from the overall dimensions of the kit, which was the base problem of the original, we also revisited some other aspects of the kit. The wing to fuselage fairing has been modified to correspond with that most often seen on the G-6 variant. We redesigned the rear part of the fuselage behind the cockpit to address criticism levied against the fuselage outline at about the second former after the canopy. While we were at it, we modified the progression of the individual fuselage segments to better represent the appearance of the real thing. We did the same through to the front of the aircraft. We re-measured the whole thing, systematically photographed it and, last but not least, we got down and dirty with it prior to redesigning the kit. None of this was a particularly simple affair, but the end result is more than interesting and I am certain that most modelers will be rather pleasantly surprised. I am looking forward to releasing the information surrounding this updated effort, including details of the study of the real McCoy, via our now typical and sometimes controversial marketing campaign.



There will be much to explain, the result will raise eyebrows, will be fresh and will be effective. Realistically, I expect to release this puppy in the fall, likely with an E-day premiere.

Last year I mentioned a forthcoming revolution in 1/72nd scale, and the time has come. It will be here as early as February, in the bloodless and non-violent form of the Royal Class Avia B.534. Part of the revolution will encompass the release format for kits in 1/72nd scale, where after the release of the Royal Class boxing, we will issue the Weekend Edition item prior to releasing the ProfiPACK kit. The next step will be a more intensive release schedule of new 72nd scale kits, and also re-editions of older models. Included in the development of the new kits are the UTI MiG-15, Spitfire Mk.IX/VIII and XVI, and the

Fw 190A-5/A-8/F-8. These kits, except for the UTI MiG-15, are downscaled from their respective 1/48th scale kits, but are significantly modified to reflect the difference in scale and, while maintaining a high level of detail, to not complicate their assembly. Each kit will be accompanied by the availability of new photoetched detail and Brassin resin sets. Our goal is to bring to the market high quality

1/72nd scale kits at a reasonable price. There will be the odd deviation from the release schedule template, and in the case of the Spitfire Mk.IX, it will be out first with a 'The Boys are Back' kit, copying the same format as in 1/48th.

With respect to kits in 1/48th scale, besides the above mentioned Bf 109G, this year will see a continuation of the Spitfire line, with the Spitfire Mk.VIII and Mk.XVI. The first ProfiPACK kit will see the light of day in March. The kit will be significantly modified and will not be a simple conversion of the Mk.IX. The kit contains a new fuselage and wings along with a list of new fine details, such as all-new landing gear. A feature of the kit will be the inclusion of the extended wing tips for high altitude performance. This will be followed by a Limited Edition kit covering the Spitfire Mk.VIII in Australian service and will include a publication dedicated to the kit theme. The Spitfire Mk.XVI is anticipated in the fall. This will also incorporate a new fuselage with a bubble canopy but will also include the classic fuselage with a raised spine and standard cockpit.

Another new 48th scale kit will be the SE-5a. It's the next in our Great War line and this kit was well worth the extra effort. This kit will satisfy the most demanding fan of the type, and the level of detail approaches extreme. It represents our current peak of WWI subjects and the fact that we put a lot of effort into it shows. The SSW D.III was outsourced and unfortunately it shows, and so

we will be doing the SE-5a ourselves. Guess you reap what you sow....

We are also working on a new 1/144 scale kit, but because this will be the price of admissions kit for E-day, 2015, the subject matter won't be released anytime soon. So we don't run into the same wall as we did with last year's MiG-15, we are working on the new project now. But, all being said, the MiG ended well, didn't it? It surpassed my own expectations. And that goes for both scales....1/72 and 1/144. We will continue to release kits of the family in 1/144 with the next one slated to be the MiG-15bis in February.

Turning our attention to Limited Edition kits, January sees the release of the first Starfighter, under the name 'BUNDESFLIEGER' and covers the F-104G in the colors of the Luftwaffe. This will be followed up with two more kits, the first one also of the F-104G but in the services of European nations in NATO, and the second one will be the Japanese F-104J which we expect to accompany with a theme related publication. I probably don't need to mention that the plastic in these kits hails from Haswagawa. This year, we will also continue on with the Phantoms using Academy's kit released as a 'Good Evening, Da Nang!' boxing, focusing on the F-4C/D of the USAF. This will be followed up by the F-4J at the end of the year. In co-operation with Hasegawa, we are planning a third Limited Edition package using their A-4 in 1/48th scale. The version is not certain at this point, but will most likely be the early A-4E/F used in Vietnam. That covers the Limited Edition plans for 2015. To be continued....

This year, we will initiate at least two new projects in 1/48th scale and two in 1/72nd, one of which will be the long-awaited MiG-21.

No major changes are in the works in terms of photoetched and Brass releases. We will be focusing on getting all we can out of our new etching capa-

bilities including the etching of steel to include in our lineup. We will be endeavoring to make our resin bits easier to put together and to make the instructions clearer....a seemingly simple task. Every year at this time I usually outline our results from the previous year. Unfortunately, I received the detailed year-end stats with a slight delay, and so this information will have to wait until February's newsletter. For now, I can report that with just under 100 million crowns in sales, this was the most successful year in our history.

As usual, we will be attending Nuremberg from January 28th. If you are in

the neighborhood, we'd love to see you at our booth in Hall 7. This year's E-day will be at the same venue at Butovice on September 27 and 28, 2015. With respect to the first show of the year, that will be the Panther's Cup in Prosek.

In closing, my friends, I wish you a successful and healthy 2015, and a good read within this newsletter!

SSW D.III, Jasta 4, Lt. Ernst Udet, Metz, October 3, 1918

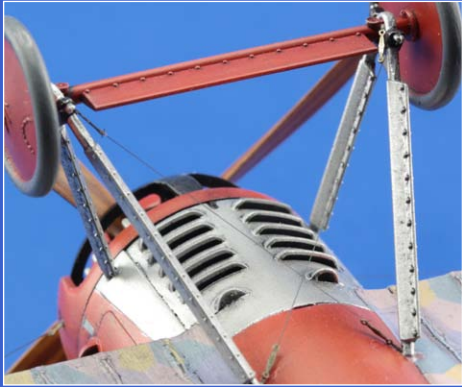
Ernst Udet was photographed in the cockpit of this aircraft on October 3, 1918. He was a holder of the Pour-le-Merite and Knight's Cross, and was a 62 kill ace. But the Staffelführer of Jasta 4 never flew this aircraft in combat, and it is unlikely that he ever flew it at all. On September 26, seven DH9s of No.99 Squadron IAF attacked the

train station at Metz, and these were bounced by German aircraft on their return flight. Five of the bombers were downed over enemy territory, and two crash landed with dead gunners. Two of these kills were credited to Udet. He was wounded by a round to the thigh, and flew no more combat missions. The inscription LO! On the fuselage

also appeared on other of Udet's aircraft. It was a familiar reference to his lady friend Eleonor Zink. The extent of the red paint on the aircraft is not entirely clear from available photographs.
